# A welcome from St Andrew's Church



Whether you have moved to Moretonhampstead as a single vperson, young family, or you have chosen to retire here, we hope that this pack will give you an overview of the facilities and services available in and around the town, and hopefully make your introduction to the community as seamless as possible.



## Public Transport

**BUS SERVICES,** provided by CountryBus, run to Exeter, Newton Abbot and Okehampton daily (not Sunday), starting from Court Street car park and then picking up in The Square.

The Exeter service is best covered, with several buses to and from Exeter throughout the day.

Newton Abbot and Okehampton have only one direct return trip from Moreton (in the morning), but it is possible to return from either via Exeter (if you have plenty of time!). There is also a weekly bus (on Wednesday mornings) to Newton Abbot, giving a return journey calling at Trago shopping centre. This is also quite a scenic route, via Manaton.

In addition there is the summer-only (mid-June to end of August) double-decker Dartmoor Explorer bus that runs each day including Sundays between Exeter and Tavistock via Moretonhampstead.

Bus timetables are available free from the Information Centre, and there are also timetables displayed at Court Street car park, and the bus stop outside Moreton House.

There are railway stations at Exeter, Newton Abbot, Okehampton and Yeoford – this latter is useful for trips towards Barnstaple.

There are no filling stations in Moretonhampstead or on the moor between Moretonhampstead and Yelverton or Tavistock. The nearest 24-hour facilities are at Whiddon Down (on the A30) and at Bovey Straight, just south of Bovey Tracey (on the A382).

There are no public electric charging points for cars locally.



## Local Churches

#### ST ANDREW'S PARISH CHURCH

St Andrew's Parish Church stands at the end of Fore Street, and dates back to the 15th century, although the original stone church was built in the 13th century.

You are warmly invited to pop into the church and have a look around, or join the congregation for one of the services. You will be made very welcome.

There is normally a service at 9.30 am on a Sunday, but occasionally there is a service at one of our sister churches at Lustleigh, Manaton or North Bovey. Full details of all services are displayed in the church porch and also on the website: moretonbenefice.uk

# Sport and Leisure



There are several opportunities in Moretonhampstead to take part in sporting and leisure activities.
